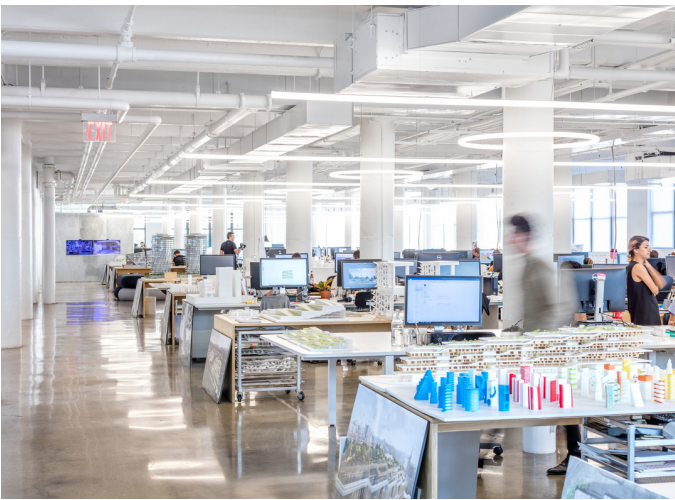

### Gople Outdoor

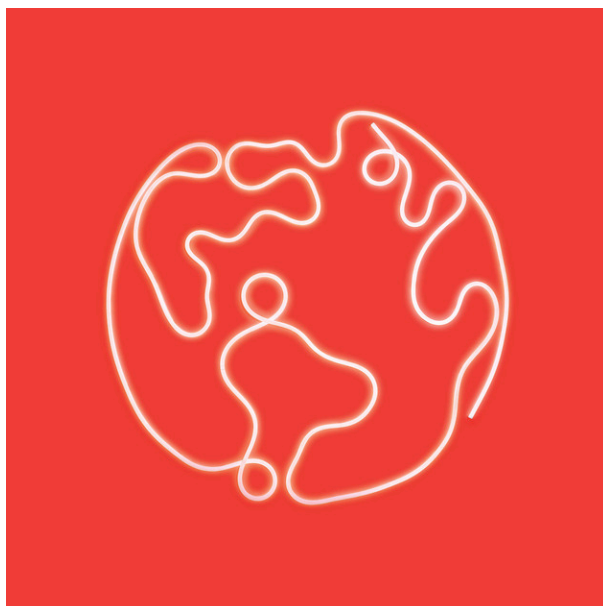
Bringing the iconic Gople shape into exterior spaces.

## Arctic

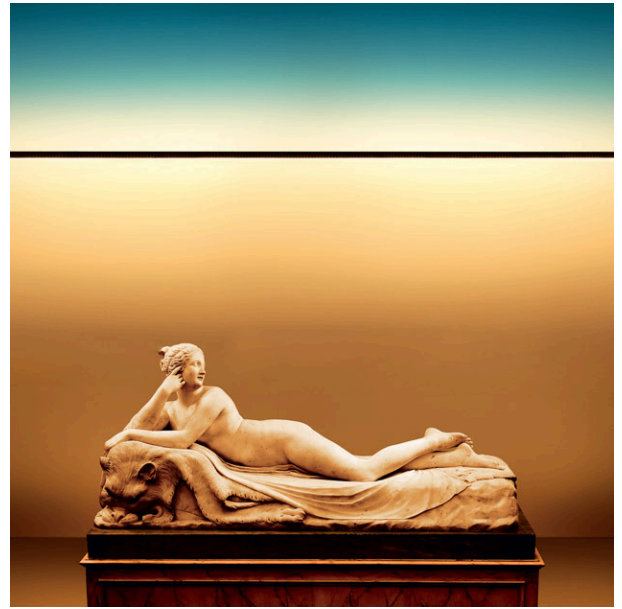
Reflection, transparency, and light come together in a geometric luminous composition.
